

Acts 1:8 Study Questions

Begin by praying Psalm 67:1-5 verse by verse.

Read Acts 1:8

Point 1 - The Gospel is multicultural

What point is Jesus trying to make when he names the four locations: Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and the end of the earth?

If someone were to say that taking the Gospel to the entire earth was only the mission of the first disciples, what other Scriptures could you point to that shows every Christian's responsibility?

How can we take the Gospel to the nations here at home?

Are there cultures which intimidate you or you aren't sure how to reach? Instead of remaining the same, how do you think our hearts could begin to change?

Share an encouraging story from cross-cultural missions or a lesson learned when things didn't go as planned.

Point 2 - The Gospel is Reproductive

What is something that you find yourself repeatedly sharing with others? What makes it so appealing, attractive to share?

How are we a witness to Jesus? What does being a witness to Jesus presuppose about our connection to Him?

List 3 people who you can begin praying for opportunities to share with/love/serve.

Point 3 - The Gospel is Transformative

In whose power were the disciples supposed to be witnesses?

Read Romans 8:11 and John 16:7

What do these verses tell us about the importance of the Holy Spirit in a believer's life?

How can we be more sensitive to the Holy Spirit's leading and empowering?
